Drawing & Painting

Rules:

1. All drawings and paintings must be original and not copied from other pictures or photographs
2. Commercial or copyrighted designs will be disqualified.
3. In order to protect entries from wear and tear, mounting, framing or matting must be sturdy enough to withstand handling.
4. All pictures must have appropriate heavy-duty hanging devices attached. Yarn, string, pop tops, paper clips, coat hangers, etc. are not acceptable hanging devices.
5. Exhibitor's name and date of completion must be visible on the back of the entry for ease of identification. If item cannot be labeled directly, attach a card with your name and date.

The Dorothy McNeill Art Award will be given to one junior fair exhibitor showing drawing, painting, or hand-built pottery. This “Best of Show” award is given to the artist who represents the ideals and creativity of Dorothy McNeill. The award includes a plaque. Dorothy was a life-long Iowa County resident who attended 96 consecutive Iowa County Fairs and earned many blue ribbons on her art exhibits.
