Knitting

Rules:

1. All items except displays must be accompanied by a 3x5 card securely fastened to entry with the following information:
 - a. Fiber content of yarn
 - b. Intended care
 - c. Intended use (was garment made for someone else)
 - d. Pattern stitch used
 - e. Size of knitting needles used
 - f. Source of pattern (name of publication)
 - g. Gauge used
2. Failure to do the above may result in a lower placing.
3. All entries must contain at least 1 oz of yarn including the fringe. If you wish to exhibit an article containing less than 1 oz of yarn (example Christmas ornaments), bring three articles.
4. A pair of mittens, slippers, pot holders, etc. constitutes one article. Articles with more than one item should be fastened together.

Crocheting

Rules:

1. All items except displays must be accompanied by a 3x5 card securely fastened to the entry with the following information:
 - a. Fiber content, of yarn
 - b. Intended care
 - c. Intended use (was garment made for someone else)
 - d. Pattern stitch used
 - e. Size of crochet hook used
 - f. Source of pattern (name of publication)
 - g. Gauge used
2. Failure to do the above may result in a lower placing

3. All entries must contain at least 1 oz of yarn including the fringe. If you wish to exhibit an article containing less than 1 oz of yarn (example Christmas ornaments), bring three articles.
4. A pair of mittens, slippers, pot holders, etc. constitutes one article. Articles with more than one item should be fastened together.
5. Posters may not exceed 14x22" in size
